RECOMMENDED ACTION

1. Accept the 2024 Coalition for Clean Air Microgrant in the amount of \$500; and
2. Adopt a budget amendment resolution authorizing an increase in revenue and appropriation of expenditures in the amount of \$500 to the Clean Air Grant Account; and
3. Authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute all necessary documents to implement and administer the funded programs.

DISCUSSION

California Clean Air Day is a statewide initiative created and spearheaded by the Coalition for Clean Air (CCA) Organization. CCA was founded in 1971 and focuses on advocating for clean air solutions across the state of California. Each October, organizations and community groups participate in California Clean Air Day to promote emission reducing habit changes and educating the public about air quality topics. In 2023, over 330 organizations, 22 transit agencies, and 16,500 individual participants submitted pledges and/or hosted events on Clean Air Day. For the past several years, Menifee has committed to participating in this statewide effort through City Council proclamation and a series of community events designed to be fun and engaging. Additionally, these activities help to further community knowledge of state emission reduction legislation under Senate Bill 1383.

In recognition of October 2, 2024, as Clean Air Day in California, the Community Services Department has organized a series of activities during the first week of October. These activities include contests, social media campaigns, an employee event, and the Electric Car Show and Clean Air Expo, scheduled for Saturday, October 5, 2024, at Mt. San Jacinto College. To recognize Menifee's participation in Clean Air Day efforts, CCA has awarded a \$500 microgrant

to support these activities as part of its annual competitive microgrant program. Funding for the microgrant would be used to purchase prizes and refreshments for event participants.

FISCAL IMPACT

The fiscal impact for the acceptance of the grant is \$500 in both revenue and expenditures, to be recognized in Fiscal Year 2024/2025. The Finance Department would increase the budgeted local grant revenue in the Grant Fund (2301-441004) and appropriate those funds to the Clean Air Grant within the Grant Fund (2301-CSD-SWES-652844).
