After further investigation the fire was located inside the kitchen. A total of 5 people were displaced and the Red Cross assisted the residents with their needs. Meniffee Building and safety has red tagged the residence.
23CARRU144735 9/29/2023 9:01:00 PM	Haz Mat (unknown odor): The first arriving company officer reported an odor coming from multiple irrigation drainages. Haz-Mat performed air monitoring in several locations, while attempting to find the source of odor. Environmental Health remained at the scene with Meniffee Public Works to clean up the drains. The odor dissipated naturally with no return or finds from air monitoring and sampling
