Since **1946**, the County of Riverside has contracted with CAL FIRE to provide regionalized fire protection, advanced life support service, technical rescue, and hazardous materials response

Cooperative Agreement between the City of Menifee and the County of Riverside for fire services renewed November 1, 2021 extending through June 30, 2024

Since **incorporation** CAL FIRE/Riverside County Fire has provided fire protection, fire prevention, rescue, and emergency medical services in the City of Menifee

Planning for the Future



- **Economies of Scale/Resiliency and Surge Capacity**
 - **County assets:** 83 municipal fire engines, 9 brush engines, 8 ladder trucks, 18 squads/ patrols, hazmat unit, 4 breathing supports, utility trucks, dozer, reserve squads, 3 communications / incident support units, 32 chief officers.
 - **State assets:** 17 wildland fire engines, 3 planes, 1 helicopter, 3 bull dozers, 19 fire crews, 24 chief officers
 - Administration, human resources, information technology, 911 dispatch, public information/communications, arson team, emergency medical services, training programs, cost recovery, supplies and equipment.

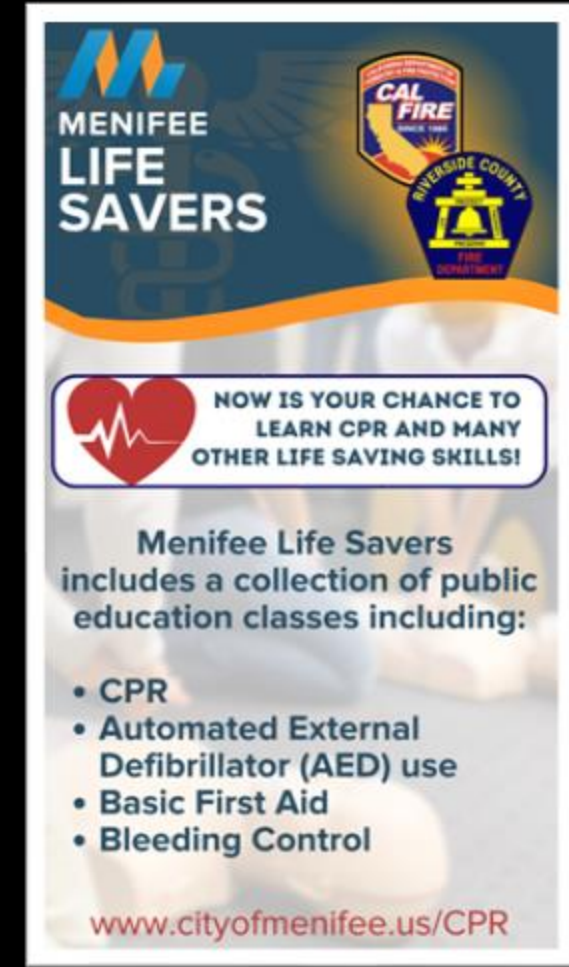

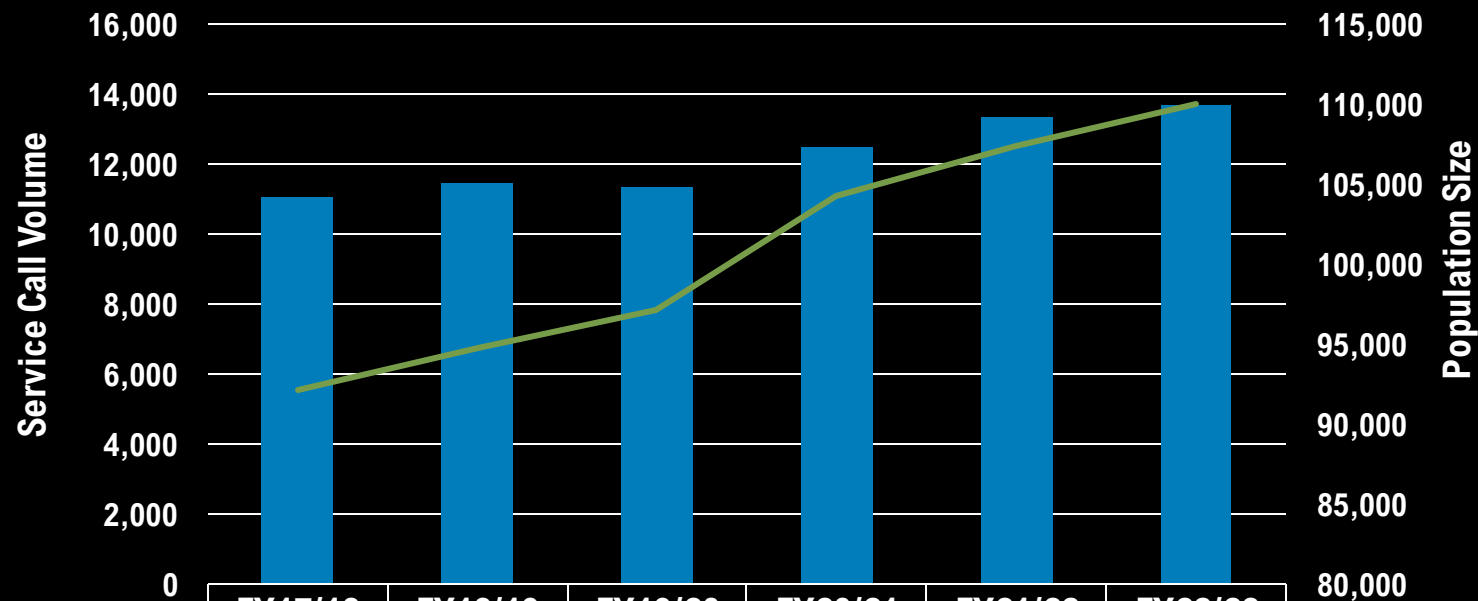


Committed to facilitating Fire and Life Safety solutions through innovation and partnership

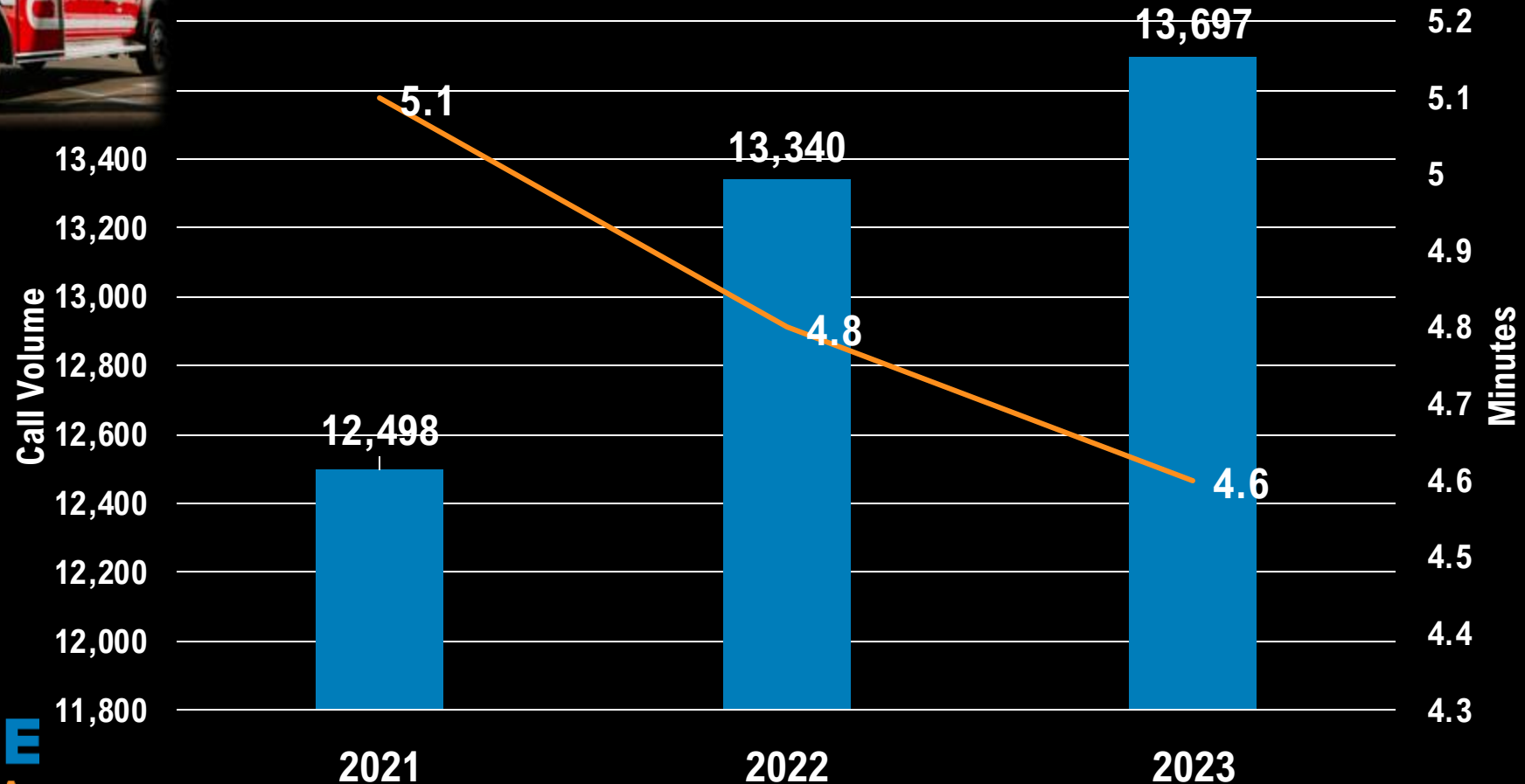

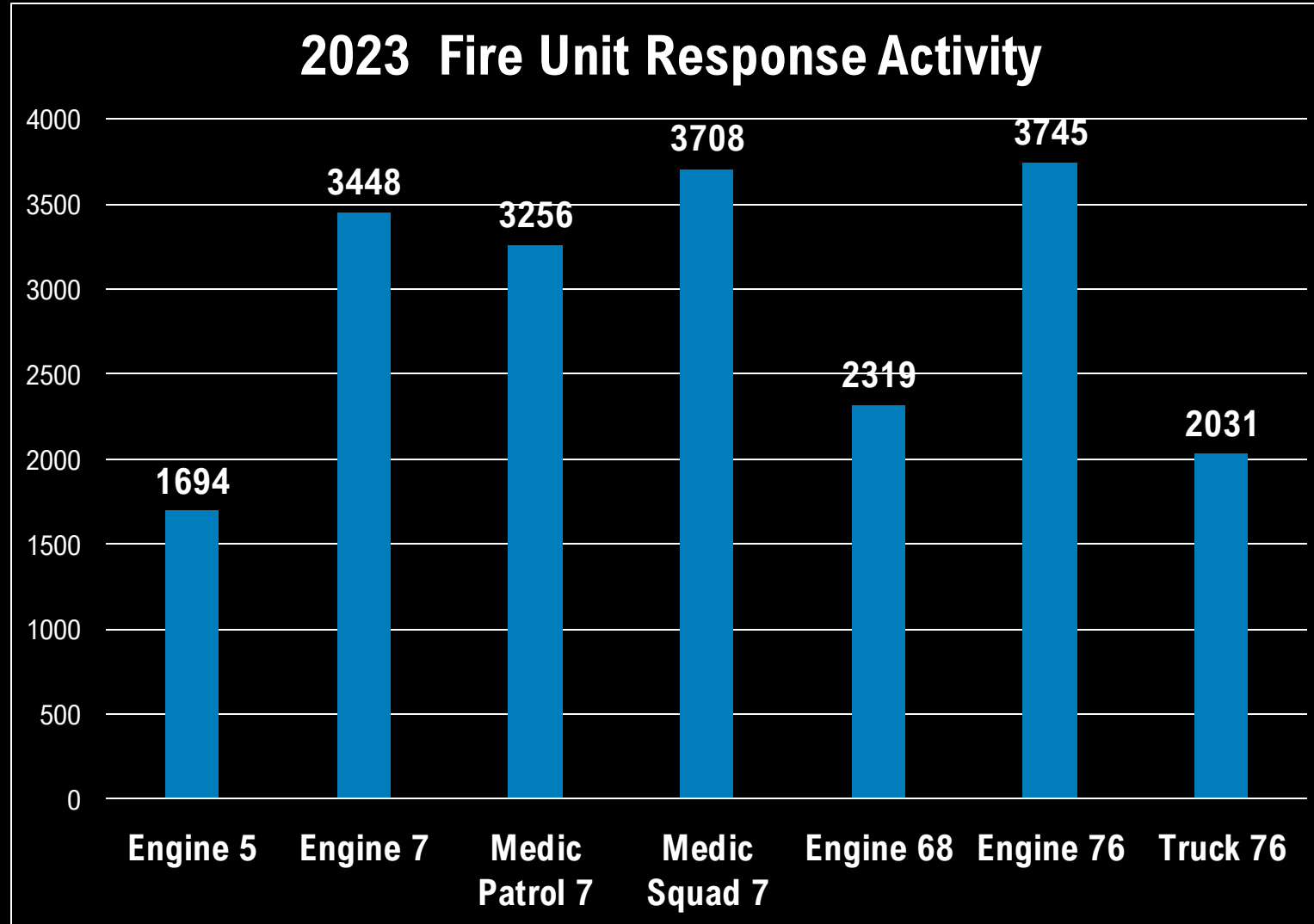
Medic Squad Added - September 2022

Fire Services - Call Thresholds

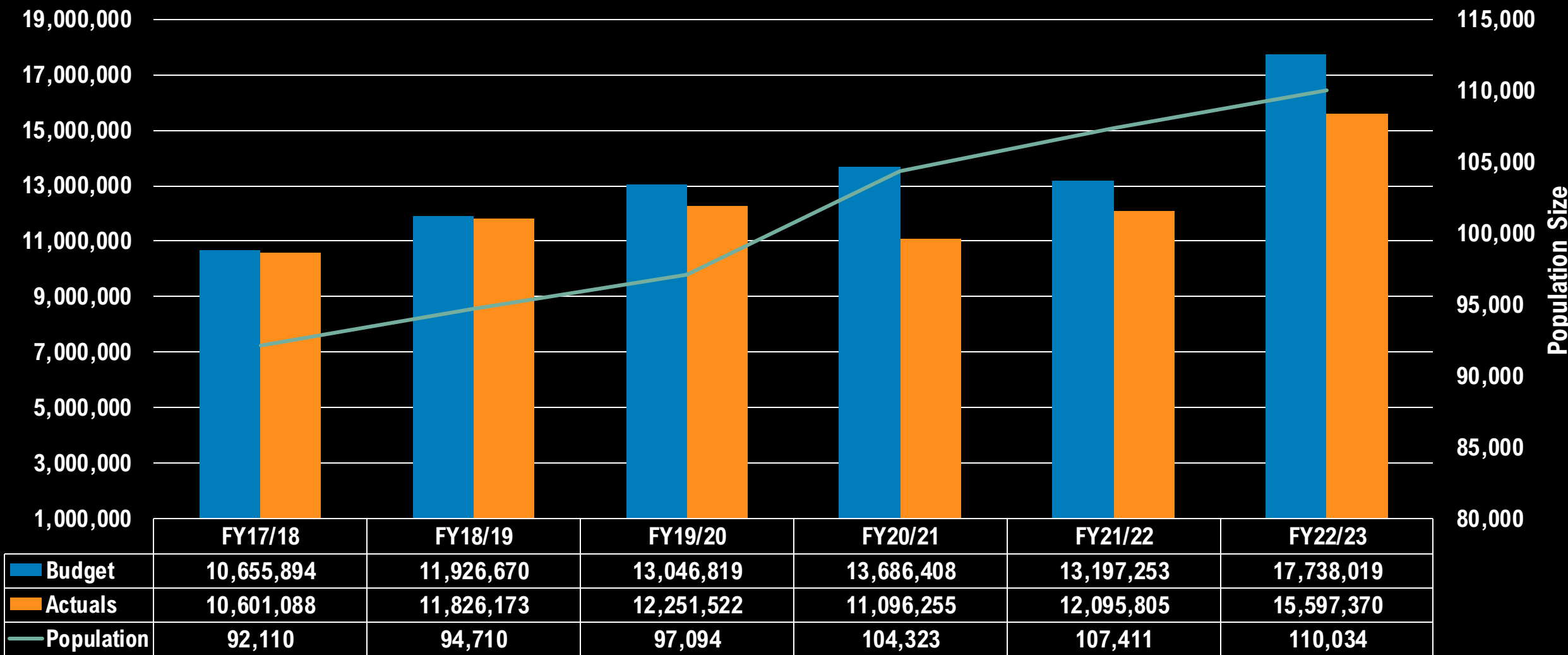

Fire Station Distribution - Current



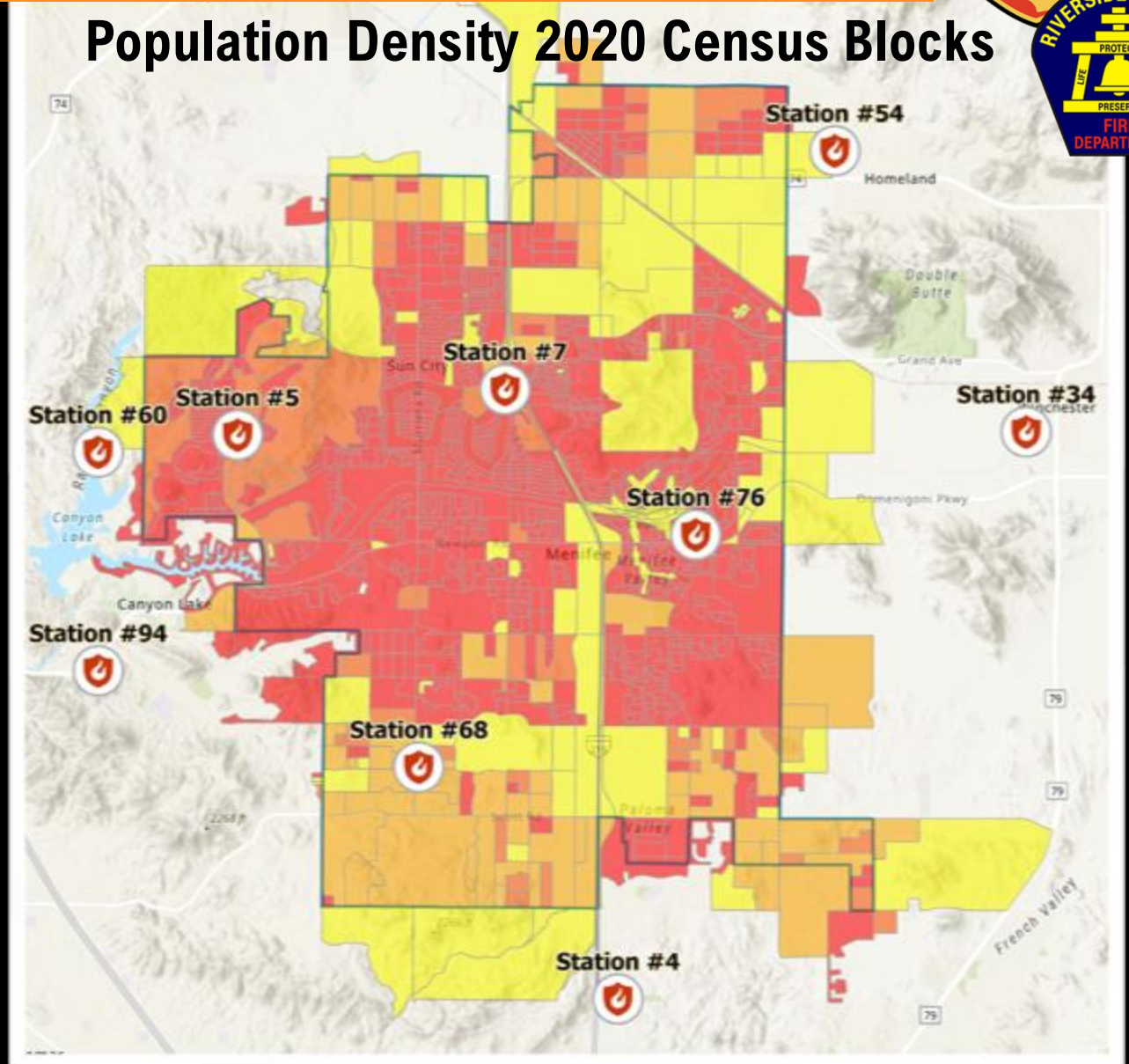

Fire Station Distribution - Proposed

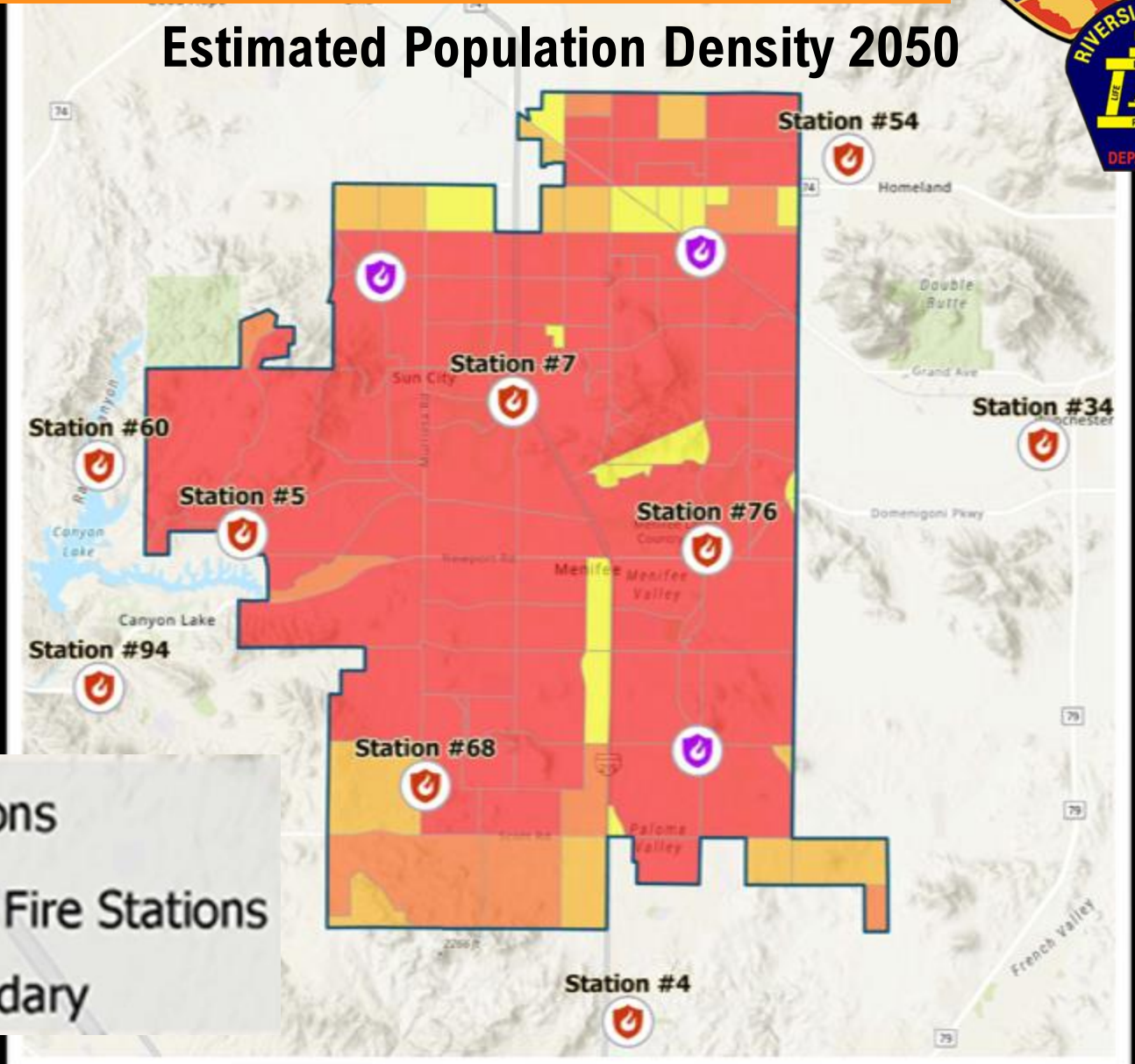
