

## Significant Incidents

24CARRU138831 9/8/2024 3:00:00PM	Riverside County Fire Department received multiple calls reporting down trees and powerlines at the above location after a severe storm. Firefighters responded to several locations to evaluate reports of down electrical lines and trees. One incident resulted in a large tree falling across Edison powerlines and crushing an unoccupied truck. Firefighter remained in the area until 7PM when no additional requests for 911 services were made. Menifee police and public works assisted with traffic control. Edison will be making repairs overnight to restore electrical power in the affected areas.
