Statement of Interest

My name is Jeff White, and I am writing to formally express my interest in serving on the Menifee City Council to represent District 2. I have been a dedicated resident of District 2 in Menifee for the past nine years. Prior to this, I graduated from Paloma Valley High School in 2003. In 2004, I moved to Murrieta and began my career as an Automotive Technician. During my time in Murrieta, I worked my way up from a car washer to an Automotive Technician at the Murrieta Mitsubishi Dealer, gaining valuable skills and experience along the way.

My career progressed significantly when I joined UPS as a fleet technician, where I was selected from 100 candidates. Over eight years, I developed expertise in various fuel systems, including electric, gas, diesel, CNG, LNG, propane, and hydrogen fuel vehicles. I successfully managed a fleet of 62 vehicles, improving reliability and reducing costs. This role required me to be self-taught, with minimal formal schooling provided by the manufacturer, which honed my ability to learn and adapt quickly.

I then advanced to a management position at UPS, overseeing the second-largest repair facility in California. In this role, I managed a budget of \$3.5 million and was responsible for 24 technicians and a large fleet of vehicles, including 255 heavy-duty tractors, 45 spotters, and 323 package cars, along with a trailer shop. My responsibilities included budget management, parts supply, technician training, and ensuring operational efficiency. Managing such a significant budget required meticulous tracking and smart decision-making to ensure cost efficiency while maintaining high standards of service.


