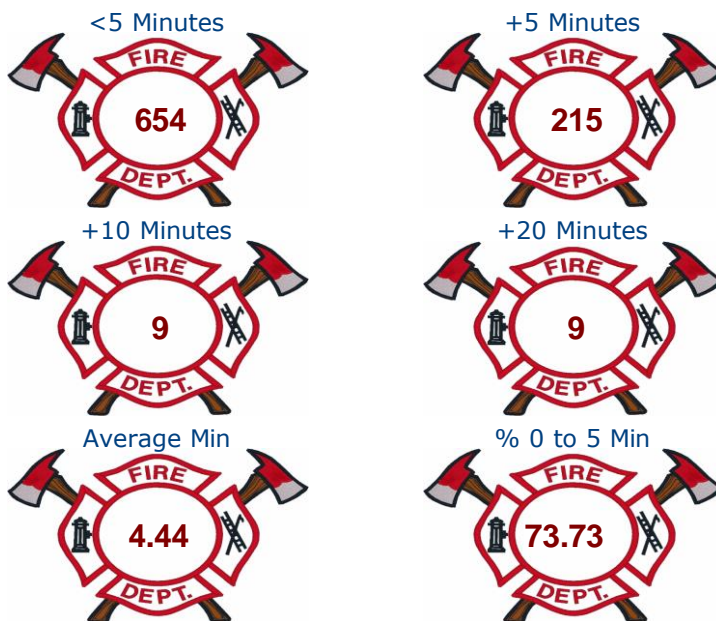

## Significant Incidents

23CARRU191741 12/24/2023 9:42:00PM	Multiple units responded to a reported traffic collision with patients trapped in the area of Bradley Rd and Rio Vista. The first arriving fire engine reported a single vehicle upside down with major damage in approximately three feet of water. The patient was extricated from the vehicle and transported to a local area trauma center for treatment.
23CARRU192052 12/25/2023 12:39:00PM	Multiple units were dispatched to a reported residential structure fire in the 29000 block of Maritime Way. The first arriving fire engine reported a single-story single-family residence with smoke showing from the residence. Firefighters were able to keep the fire to the room of origin with no extension. The result of the fire caused an approximate \$50,000 damage.
