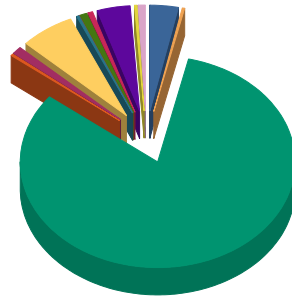

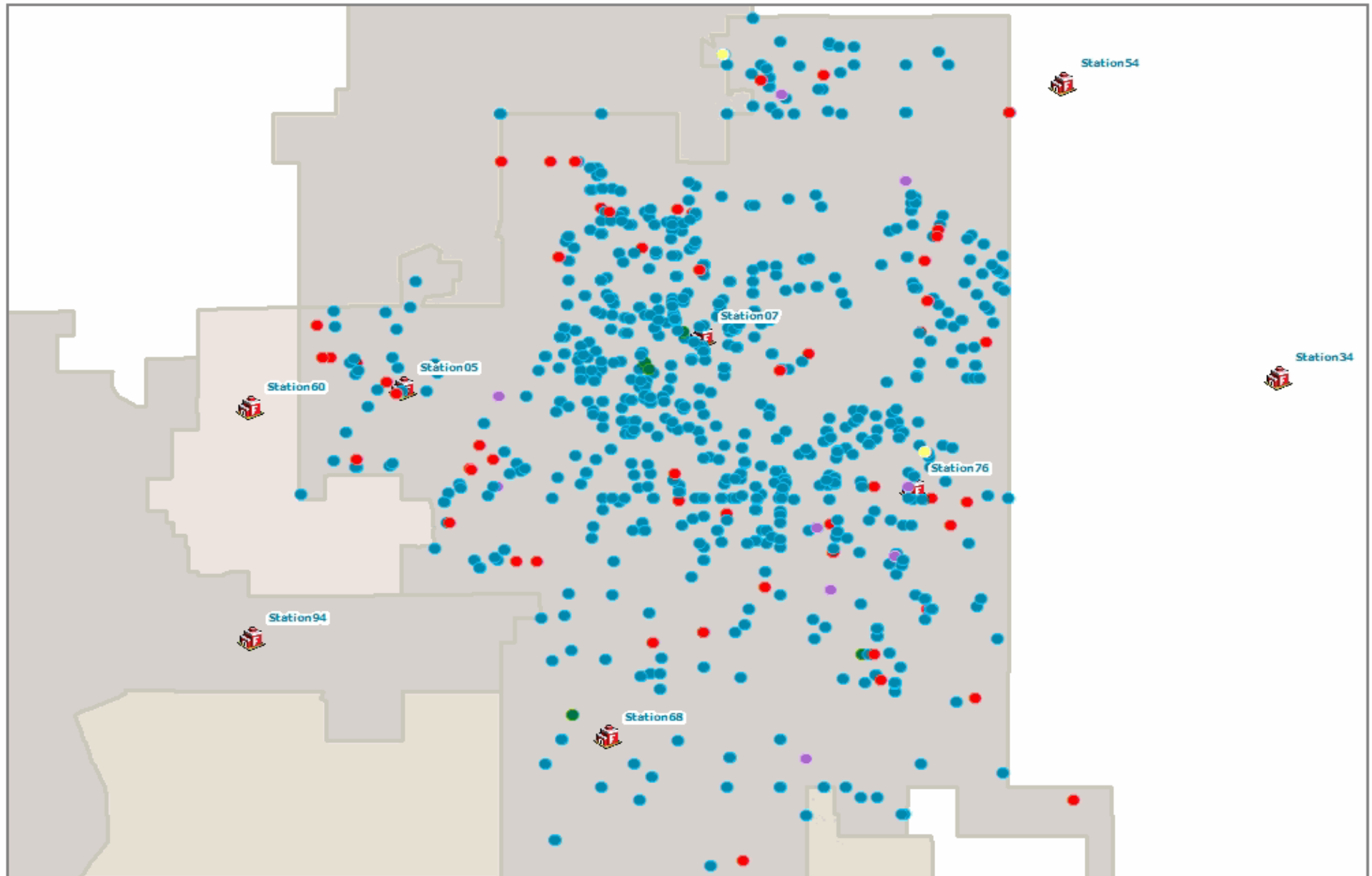

**Description of Significant Activities/Major Accomplishments:** City special events inspected: Foodie Friday's, Juneteenth, Independence Day Celebration. Plan reviews have increase from last year 6/2021 by 180 plan reviews in 6/2022. Planning applications have also increased from 6/2021 by 40 new planning cases 6/2022. Annual inspections have increased with 120 new annual inspections from same time last year. Counter services are back up after Covid closure from 28 counter contacts 6/2021 to 330 counter contacts 6/2022. Inspections have remained 100% with a 2 day turn-around 6/2022 from 70% 5 day from last year 6/2021.

### Comments/Narrative

At 1329 hours CAL FIRE / RVC Firefighters were dispatched to the given address for a reported house fire. Engine 5 from the Quail Valley station arrived and found moderate smoke from a single story house. An elderly female had exited the house suffering from smoke inhalation. AMR and Fire Department Paramedics treated the female who later refused transport to the hospital. The fire was contained at 1355 hours with fire damaging around 50 percent of the house and smoke damage around 90 percent of the house. It was determined the fire started in the laundry room and was likely started in the in wall FAC (Forced Air Conditioning) unit. The fire rapidly spread into the attic and neighboring rooms. Edison assisted and removed power to the house. City of Menifee Officials red tagged the house. One dog and one cat were found deceased during the fire attack and Riverside County Animal Control removed those pets from the scene. Red Cross is assisting with 4 adults / occupants who were displaced.
