### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

1. Adopt a resolution declaring the results of the November 8, 2022 General Municipal Election and reciting such other matters as provided by law.

### **DISCUSSION**

In a consolidated election, California Elections Code section 10262(b) states that upon receipt of the results of the election from the Riverside County Registrar of Voters (ROV), the City Elections Official shall certify the results to the governing body. This action must take place not later than the next regularly scheduled city council meeting following presentation of the 28-day canvass of the returns, or at a special meeting called for this purpose. The City received the final vote count from the ROV on December 6, 2022, dated December 1, 2022. The results are attached.

Per Elections Code section 10263, the City Council shall adopt a resolution reciting the facts of the election and declare elected persons for whom the highest numbers of voters were cast for each office before installing the new officers.

In District 2, Ricky Estrada received the highest number of votes.

Pursuant to Elections Code Section 10229 the City Council held a special meeting on August 24, 2022 to consider the appointment of Incumbent Dean Deines. As Dean Deines was the only District 4 candidate to apply and qualify for the November 8th election, and there were no other city-wide actions to be placed on the ballot as it related to the City of Meniffee, District 4, the City Council had the option to cancel the election for District 4 and appoint the qualified candidate. The City Council adopted Resolution No. 22-1199 and appointed Dean Deines as the District 4 Councilmember. Pursuant to Elections Code Section 10229 Councilmember Deines shall serve exactly as if elected at the municipal election.
