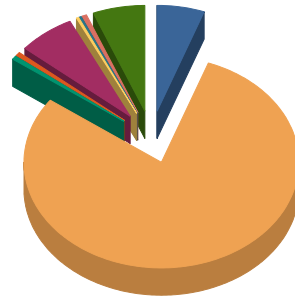

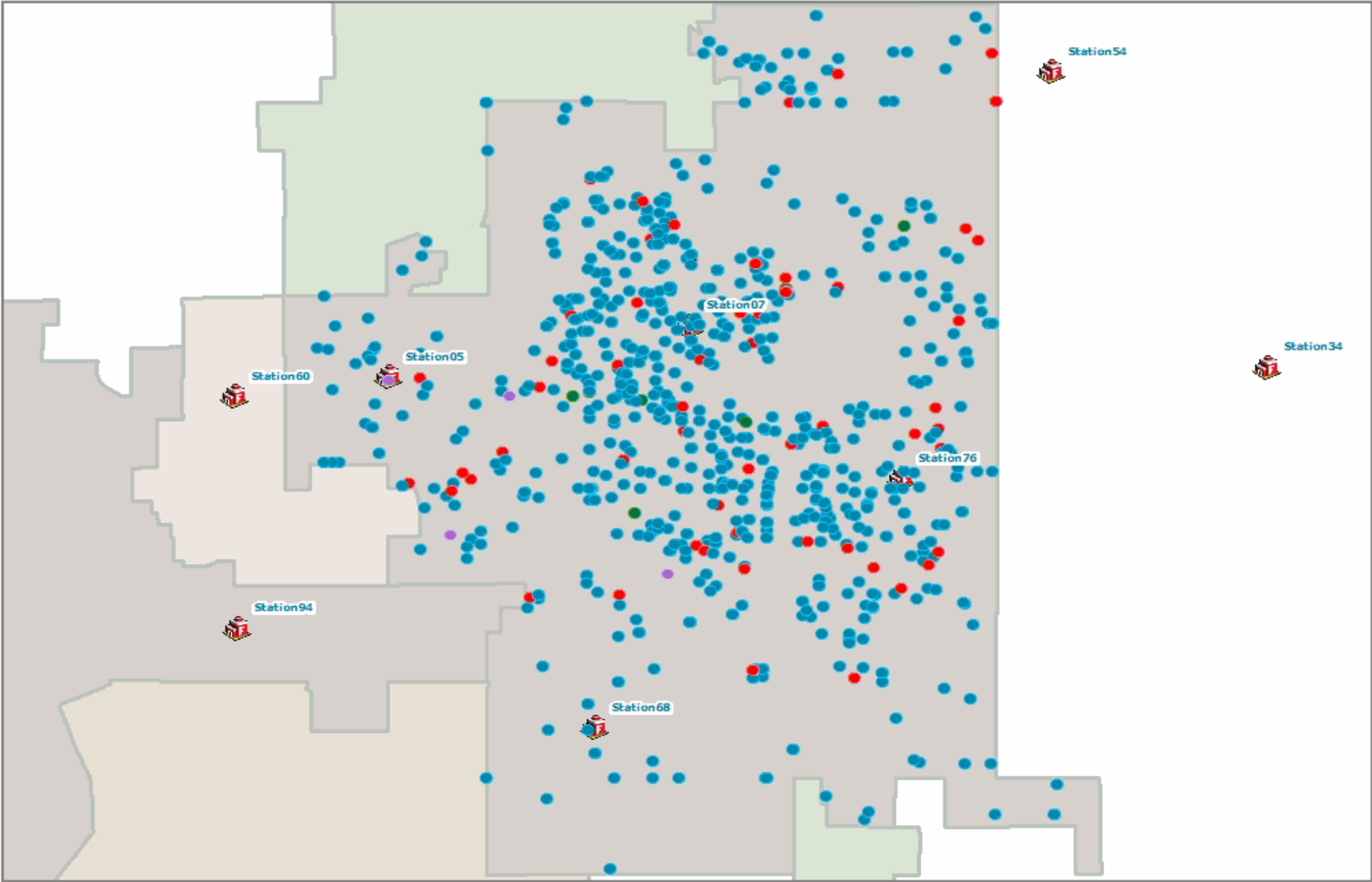

Comments/Narrative

Cal Fire Riverside County Fire Department received several calls of a multi vehicle accident at the location above. First unit at scene (T76) reported a 5 vehicle traffic collision with a total of 9 patients. An MPI was declared by the IC and a total of 5 ambulances were requested. One patient required the use of extrication tools (jaws of life) and was extricated within 9 minutes. A total of 5 patients were transported to local trauma center with minor to moderate injuries and 3 patients signed AMA. There was minor to moderate damage to one SCE power pole. SCE was requested to the scene. No Firefighters were injured during this incident.
