## RESOLUTION PC 23-\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MENIFEE, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE ROUGH GRADING AND RESTORATION OF 7.8 ACRES (GP22-019) LOCATED EAST OF TRUMBLE ROAD, SOUTH OF WATSON ROAD, WEST OF SHERMAN ROAD AND NORTH OF ILLINOIS AVENUE

**WHEREAS**, on April 15, 2022, the applicant, North Pacific Developments, Inc., filed a formal application with the City of Menifee for a Rough Grading Permit (GP 22-019) for the rough grading and restoration of 7.8 acres; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), an Initial Study ("IS") and Mitigated Negative Declaration ("MND") have been prepared to analyze and mitigate the project's potentially significant environmental impacts; and

**WHEREAS**, between February 13, 2023, and March 6, 2023, the twenty-(20)-day public review period for the Draft IS/MND took effect, which was publicly noticed by a publication in a newspaper of general circulation, notice to owners within 500 feet of the Project site boundaries, related agencies and government agencies; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 8, 2023, the Planning Commission of the City of Menifee held a public hearing on the Project, considered all public testimony as well as all materials in the staff report and accompanying documents for the adoption of the IS/MND for Grading Permit No. 22-019, which hearing was publicly noticed by a publication in *The Press Enterprise*, *SB Sun*, *and Dailey Bulletin*, newspapers of general circulation, an agenda posting, and notice to property owners within 500 feet of the Project boundaries, and to persons requesting public notice; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with CEQA and the IS/MND is an accurate and objective statement that fully complies with CEQA, the CEQA Guidelines and represents the independent judgment of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, no evidence of new significant impacts, as defined by CEQA Guidelines Section 15088.5, have been received by the City after circulation of the draft IS/MND which would require re-circulation; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Planning Commission of the City of Menifee makes the following Findings:

- The Planning Commission finds on the basis of the evidence presented and the whole record before it, including the IS/MND, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and any comments received, that there is no substantial evidence that the project, as mitigated, will have a significant effect on the environment.
- Section 2: The Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan ("MMRP") and a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B" and incorporated herein by reference, will assure compliance with the mitigation measures during project implementation.
- <u>Section 3:</u> The Planning Commission further finds that the adoption of the MND reflects the Planning Commission's independent judgment and analysis.
