## RESOLUTION NO. 23-\_\_\_\_

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENIFEE, CALIFORNIA, TERMINATING THE PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL EMERGENCY ADOPTED AS RESOLUTION 20-869

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Menifee Municipal Code Section 1.10.050(A)(1), while in session on March 18, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution 20-869, which found and proclaimed the existence and threatened existence of a local emergency within the City caused by the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) epidemic/pandemic; and

**WHEREAS**, since that time the City responded to the COVID-19 crisis through a variety of programs, initiatives, and safety measures; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 28, 2023, the Governor of the State of California issued a proclamation terminating the state of emergency in California related to COVID-19;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code section 8630, the City Council, after reviewing the need for continuing the local emergency, has determined that conditions no longer warrant continuing the local emergency.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MENIFEE, CALIFORNIA DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein.

**Section 2.** The Proclamation of Local Emergency, adopted as Resolution 20-869, is hereby rescinded in its entirety.

**Section 3**. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
