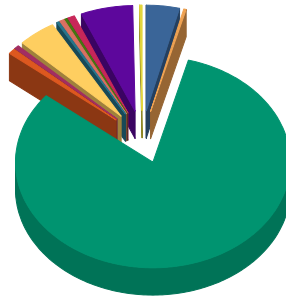

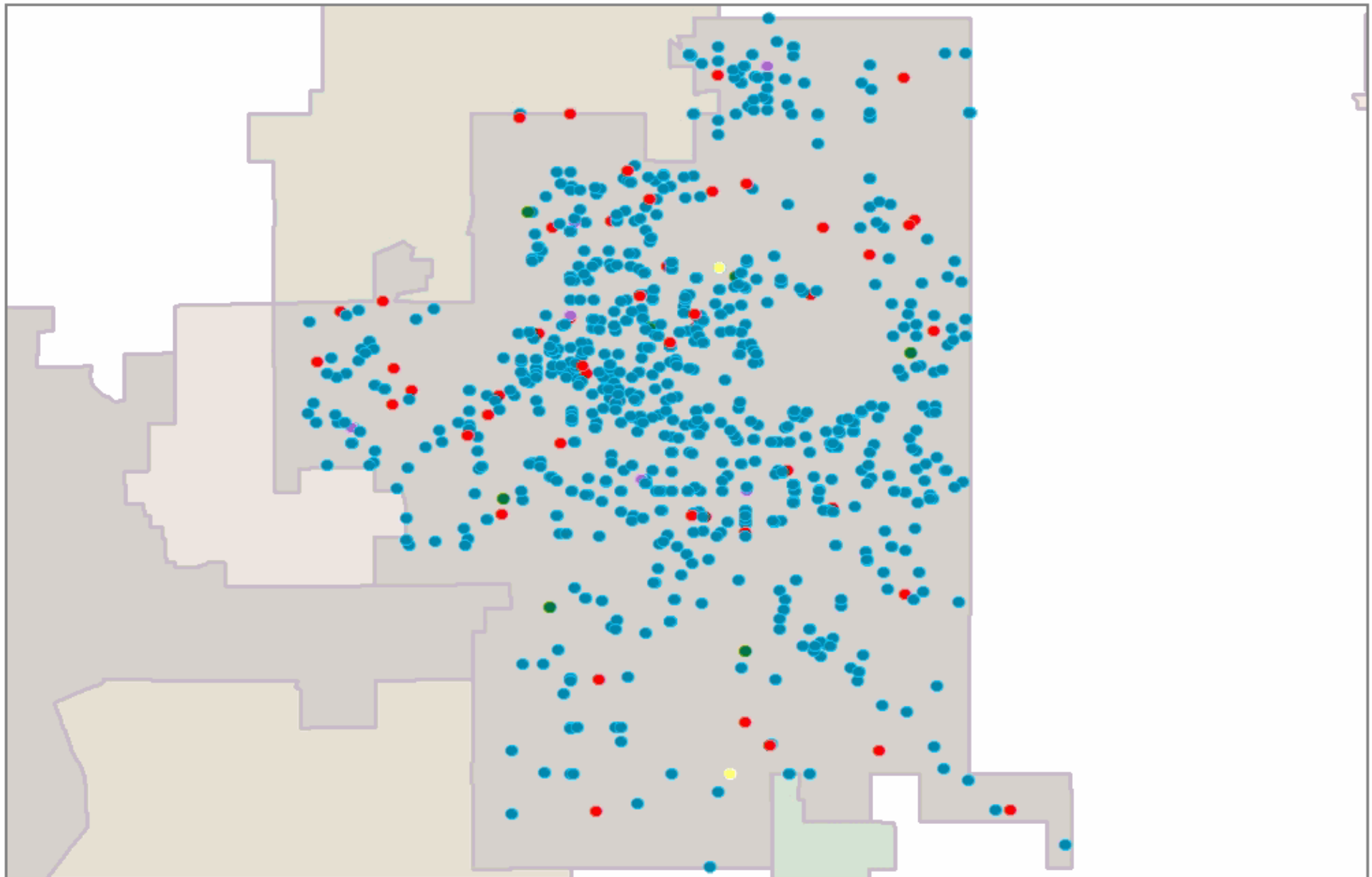

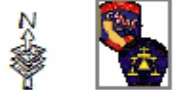

Comments/Narrative

Menifee Fire Engine 68 arrived on scene of an unknown odor coming from a classroom with several victims complaining of nausea. Precautions were taken and the building was isolated. Hazardous Materials Team from Riverside County Fire made entry and determined the odor to be sewer gas. No know hazard existed and the school returned to normal business. Two adults were transported to area hospitals for evaluation. Three victims were treated and released to their parents.
