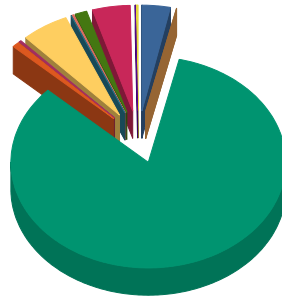

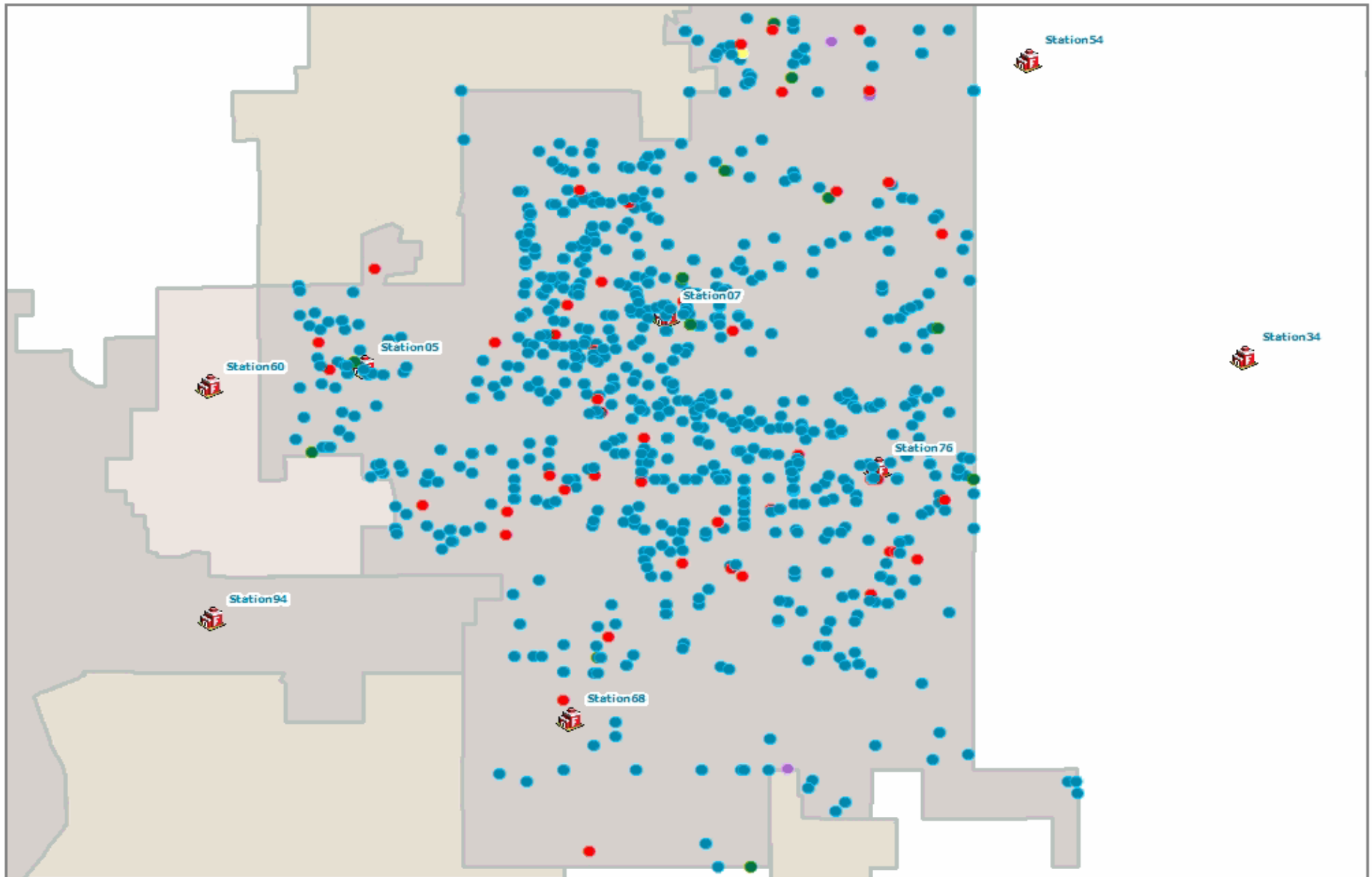

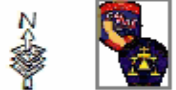

### Comments/Narrative

CAL Fire/ Riverside County Firefighters responded to a reported traffic collision with extrication at the location above. First arriving Menifee Medic Squad reported a two-vehicle accident with one vehicle requiring extrication. Crews were able to extricate one patient with moderate injuries within 10 minutes of arrival. S/B I-215 was under a full closure from Sun City Blvd to Newport Rd for approximately one hour while Menifee PD and CHP conduct their investigation. No other injuries reported.
