RECOMMENDED ACTION

1. Accept the improvements for Crack Sealing Services for the Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Slurry Seal Program, Pavement Management Project (PMP) No. 23-01, and
2. Authorize the City Clerk to file a Notice of Completion with the Riverside County Recorder's Office.

DISCUSSION

The Fiscal Year (FY) 2022/2023 Slurry Seal Program Project consists of resurfacing existing roads by slurry seal and performing restriping where appropriate. The work would be performed in various areas of the Casa Blanca community, Brigata community and the community south of Wickerd Road, as depicted in the attached Project Location Map. The Project would ultimately resurface approximately 8.5 centerline miles of roadway collectively between the neighborhoods. The Project must be completed in two phases, the first of which was a crack seal of the entire Project area. The second phase would be the slurry seal resurfacing within all identified neighborhoods. Services for slurry seal have been awarded under a separate contract.

On November 16, 2022, the City Council approved a total construction budget of \$92,869 for the crack sealing portion of the Project and authorized the City Manager to approve a construction contract with Carter Enterprises Group, Inc. dba Pavement Rehab Company in the amount of \$77,390. The estimated final construction costs for the crack sealing portion of the Project totaled \$77,390, including ancillary costs such as materials testing and labor compliance services.

If approved, a Notice of Completion (NOC) would be filed, which protects the City from future claims against the Project by providing proper noticing to each contractor, subcontractor, and

material supplier, that the Project has been completed. The payment bond would be released upon project acceptance by the City and the performance bond would be released one year after the date of recording of the NOC. The City has not received any stop notices that would prevent said releases.
