### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

1. Approve four-month extension to the Cooperative Agreement to Provide Fire Protection, Fire Prevention, Rescue and Emergency Medical Services for the City of Meniffee from July 1, 2021 through October 31, 2021.

### **DISCUSSION**

Since the City of Meniffee's incorporation, fire protection, fire prevention, rescue, and emergency medical services (Fire/EMS services) have been provided through a Cooperative Agreement with the County of Riverside. The current version of the Cooperative Agreement has a two-year term that expires on June 30, 2021.

City staff is continuing to evaluate the contract to determine whether opportunities for service enhancement or improvements can be efficiently implemented. While that process is ongoing, City staff have requested a four-month extension of the existing contract, such that it will now expire on October 31, 2021. County representatives have agreed to that extension.

The short amendment extending the period of the existing contract by four months is attached.
